§ 7100 of the Health and Safety Code: The right to control the disposition of the remains of a deceased person, the location and conditions of interment, and arrangements for funeral goods and services to be provided, unless other directions have been given by the decedent pursuant to Section 7100.1 (written instructions), vests in, and the duty of disposition and the liability for the reasonable cost of disposition of the remains devolves upon, the following in the order named:

- (1) An attorney-in-fact under a durable power of attorney for health care.
- (2) The surviving spouse.
- (3) The sole surviving adult child of the decedent, or if more than one adult child of the decedent, one-half or more of the surviving adult children...see further instructions of law if less than one-half available.
- (4) The surviving parent or parents of the decedent. If one of the surviving parents is absent, the remaining parent shall be vested with the rights and duties of this section after reasonable efforts have been unsuccessful in locating the absent surviving parent
- (5) The surviving competent adult person or persons respectively in the next degrees of kindred. If there is more than one surviving person of the same degree of kindred, the majority of those persons...see further instructions of law if less than the majority.
- (6) The public administrator when the deceased has sufficient assets.
